WORK SESSION – MAY 18, 2021

The Waseca County Board of Commissioners met in a work session on Tuesday, May 18, 2021, in the public meeting room, 300 North State Street, Waseca, Minnesota. Members present were Chair DeAnne Malterer, Doug Christopherson; Brian Harguth; Blair Nelson and Brad Krause.

Others present were Michael Johnson, County Administrator; Tammy Spooner, Auditor-Treasurer; Brad Milbrath, Sheriff; Melissa Sexton, Human Resources Manager; Brian Tomford, Buildings & Grounds Director; Mark Leiferman, Planning & Zoning Administrator and James Brady, Steele County Commissioner.

Chair Malterer called the Work Session to order at 8:05 a.m. Roll call was taken and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Brad Milbrath, Sheriff, shared history of jail discussions and issues with the current jail facility.

Brian Tomford, Buildings & Grounds Director, presented quotes for extending water and electricity at Courthouse Park. If a trench was shared for both utilities, the total cost would be approximately \$23,000.00.

Mark Leiferman, Planning & Zoning Administrator, facilitated discussions regarding Transfer of Development Rights.

Michael Johnson, Administrator, brought for discussion the lack of applicants for the Ditch Inspector position. An alternative may be to contract with a company to provide inspection services. The job description would need to be revised and the position be re-advertised.
